

# The Frog and the Mouse

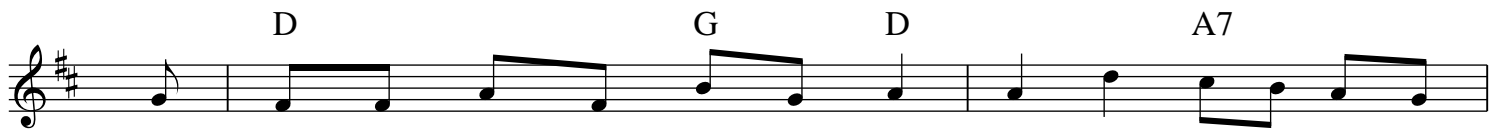
