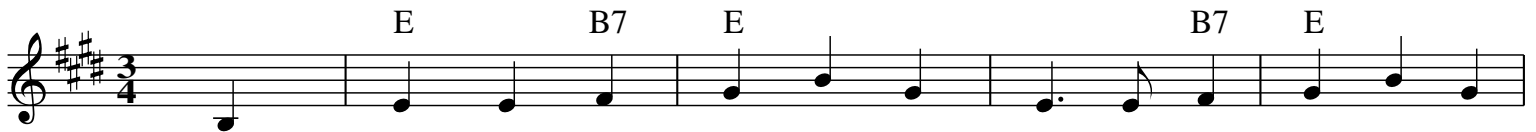


# The Marriage of the Frogge and the Mouse
